As we're approaching the middle of cold and flu season, we wanted to take a minute to remind you of our illness policies. These policies are put in place to prevent the spread of illness, and need to be followed as we are not licensed or equipped to care for mildly ill children. Here is an excerpt from our Parent Handbook:

If the following conditions occur, your child MUST remain out of the center:

- Any undiagnosed rash • Intestinal disturbances (vomiting/diarrhea)
- Sore or discharging eyes, ears, or profuse nasal discharge • Temperature of 101 or more
- The contagious stage of any communicable disease • Viral symptoms

A child must be free of persistent fever (without pain reliever), vomiting, or diarrhea for at least 24 hours before returning to the center. Children should be able to participate in the daily activities of his/her class before returning to the center.
